- ❖ Group confirmation will be emailed to the group leader when your registration is received. Once camp registration is closed you will receive an information packet with directions to camp, suggested packing list, and other information to be copied and shared with your campers.
- ❖ **Completed forms must accompany fees for registration to be confirmed.**
- ❖ Each mother and daughter team must complete a registration form. If a mother/guardian has two or more daughters attending, she should complete one form for each daughter.
- ❖ **NO FOOD or DRINKS** in the cabins so un-welcome guests do not enter cabins.
