- 1. PSC elected by church
- 2. PSC training
- 3. PSC organized
- 4. PSC becomes a team
- 5. Develop a community profile
- 6. Conduct church pastoral profile survey
- 7. Develop a pastoral profile
- 8. Develop a compensation package
- 9. Gathering and processing resumes
- 10. Contact prospective pastors to see if they are still available
- 11. Prioritize final resumes (no more than 5)
- 12. Contact references and discuss information on one minister at a time
- 13. Meet the candidate and spouse
- 14. Hear the candidate preach
- 15. Meeting on the church field to finalize issues with the candidate
- 16. Present candidate to the church
- 17. Church votes on the candidate
- 18. Pastor moves to the church field
